Resurrection Eggs

Crown of Thorns



(Matthew 27:27-31)

"[They] twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on his head."

Cloth



(Mark 27:42-47)

"Then he wrapped [Jesus' body] in the linen cloth and placed it in the tomb."

Nails on Cross



(Mark 15:21-32)

"They nailed his hands and feet to the cross."

Stone



(Matthew 57:62-28)

"He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb."

Spear



(John 19:28-37)

"One of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear."

Empty Tomb



(Matthew 28)

"He is not here; he has risen, just as he said!"

Palm Branch



(John 12:12-16)

"They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, 'Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.'"

Praying Hands



(Matthew 26:36-46)

"He fell with his face to the ground and prayed, 'Yet not my will but yours be done.'"

Silver Coins



(Matthew 26:14-16)

"And Judas asked, 'How much will you pay me to betray Jesus to you?' and they gave him 30 pieces of silver."

Whip



(Mark 15:1-15)

"He [Pilate] had Jesus flogged and handed him over to be crucified."

Broken Bread



(Luke 22:7-30)

"This is my body which is broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

Rooster



(Mark 14:66-72)

"Before the rooster crows twice, you [Peter] will disown me three times."
