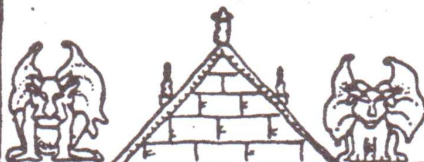


Learn about the Middle Ages by following the directions in each space.

2. Box 3 tells of a legendary person of the Middle Ages. Add missing punctuation marks. Circle letters that should be capitalized.



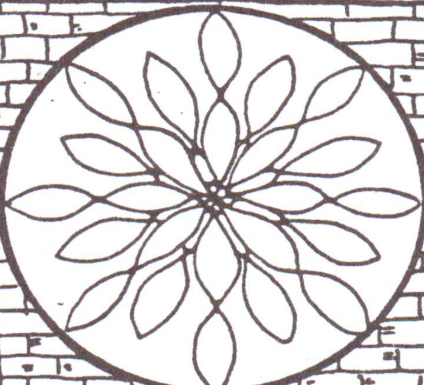
3. according to legend, robin Hood stole from the rich and gave to the poor Did you know he lived in england
