If you've been to Chatham, Massachusetts, you've probably noticed the studio of illustrator and children's book author Bob Staake. Situated on Main Street near Shore Road, the building can be identified by its' quarterboard with a single word; IMAGINE. When the cupola is glowing, it means the artist is busily at work inside -- illustrating a cover for the *The New Yorker*, designing the pages for a new picture book, or creating art for the *Washington Post*, *The Wall Street Journal* or even *MAD* magazine.

How To Assemble:

- 1: Cut all elements along dotted lines
- 2: Fold building corners and roof lines
- 3: Tape or glue yellow flaps **INSIDE** building
