

DIY SCARF DESIGN PRINT GUIDE

1. Plan Your Design

- Choose a theme (floral, abstract, etc.).
- Pick a size:
 - Square: 90x90 cm or 60x60 cm.
 - Rectangle: 50x180 cm.
- Select a color palette and sketch ideas.



5. Print and Finish

- Test a small swatch first to check colors and alignment.
- Hem edges neatly to avoid fraying.
- Steam or iron to set the design.
- And wear, gift, or sell your unique creation!

2. Choose a Printing Method

- Hand-painting: Use fabric paints, tie-dye, or block printing.
- Screen Printing: Great for bold, graphic designs.
- Digital Printing: Use online services for detailed designs.
- Heat Transfer: Print on transfer paper, then heat-press onto fabric.

3. Prepare Your Design

- Use design tools (Canva, Photoshop, etc.).
- Resolution: 300 DPI.
- Color mode: CMYK for printing.

4. Pick a Fabric

- Silk: Luxurious and vibrant.
- Cotton: Comfortable and versatile.
- Polyester: Durable, works with sublimation.
