



Easter Egg Crafts

Instruction Chart

Craft Name	Materials Needed	Instructions
Dyed Easter Eggs	Hard-boiled eggs, food coloring, vinegar, cups, spoons	Mix 1/2 cup water with 1 tsp vinegar and a few drops of food dye. Dip eggs, let dry.
Glitter Eggs	Plastic or hard-boiled eggs, glue, glitter, paintbrush	Brush glue on eggs, sprinkle glitter, let dry.
Marbled Shaving Cream Eggs	Hard-boiled eggs, whipped cream, food dye, toothpick	Spread whipped cream on a tray, add food dye, swirl, roll egg, let sit, then wipe clean.
Crayon-Resist Eggs	Hard-boiled eggs, white crayon, food dye, vinegar	Draw on the egg with a white crayon, dip in dye, let dry to reveal the design.
Pom-Pom Bunny Eggs	Plastic eggs, glue, pom-poms, googly eyes, pipe cleaners	Glue a pom-pom tail on back, googly eyes on front, and pipe cleaner ears on top.
Confetti Eggs (Cascarones)	Hollowed eggshells, confetti, tissue paper, glue	Fill an empty eggshell with confetti, seal with tissue paper, crack for fun!
Tie-Dye Paper Towel Eggs	Hard-boiled eggs, paper towels, food dye, spray bottle	Wrap egg in a paper towel, drop food dye, spray with water, let dry, unwrap.
Nature Print Eggs	Hard-boiled eggs, flowers, nylon stocking, food dye, vinegar	Press a flower onto an egg, wrap in a stocking, dip in dye, remove for a natural imprint.
Sticker Eggs	Plastic or hard-boiled eggs, Easter-themed stickers	Simply decorate eggs with fun stickers for an easy craft.
